MEETING OUTCOMES

Following the meeting between Langkawi Tourism Academy (LTA@KK Langkawi), Malaysia and Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna, Chiangmai (RMUTL) on TVET in Higher Education (Hospitality and Culinary), held on **25th May 2017** at the Department of Community College Education, agree to the following areas for cooperation and collaboration:

- A. LTA@KK Langkawi and RMUTL agree to improve the quality of TVET in Southeast Asia region by embarking on structured mobility programmes;
- B. LTA@KK Langkawi and RMUTL will support further collaboration and find best ways to encourage more teaching personnel and students from both institutions to be involved in internship, externship and mobility programmes; and
- C. LTA@KK Langkawi and RMUTL will further pursue collaboration in the agreed areas and field of study.

LTA@KK Langkawi and RMUTL have agreed to pursue these priority programmes during the period between 2017 and 2019:

- i. Two (2) weeks of Students' Externship Programme at RMUTL for LTA@KK Langkawi students;

- ii. Two (2) weeks of Students' Externship Programme at LTA@KK Langkawi for RMUTL students;
- iii. One week of Staff Exchange Programme for Two (2) LTA@KK Langkawi lecturers at RMUTL, where the sharing of experiences and knowledge transfer shall take place.
- iv. One week of Staff Exchange Programme for Two (2) RMUTL lecturers at LTA@KK Langkawi, where the sharing of experiences and knowledge transfer shall take place.

LTA@KK Langkawi and RMUTL have agreed to these terms and conditions:

- i. Host institutions shall provide accommodation, domestic transportation and teaching materials;
- ii. Cost for food, health and medical insurance coverage, international travelling expenses, student visa and personal expenses shall be borne by sending institutions;
- iii. Participants for the programme must be physically and mentally fit, and produce proof of medical wellness certified by medical doctor;
- iv. Participants must secure health insurance coverage for the whole duration of the programmes; and
- v. The programmes are based on the principle of reciprocity and mutual understanding.
